

Excellency,

I have the honour to inform you that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) will hold a **Technical Meeting of the International Network of Nuclear Reaction Data Centres** at the Global Centre for Nuclear Energy Partnership (GCNEP), Bahadurgarh, Haryana-124507, India, (<http://www.gcnep.gov.in/>), from 1 to 4 May 2018.

The purpose of the meeting is to promote the international exchange of nuclear reaction data required in nuclear sciences and technologies, to coordinate the cooperation of the thirteen participating data centres, and to discuss technical matters of the jointly operated computerized data libraries.

The meeting will be held in English.

I should be grateful if your Government would recommend experts to be designated by the Secretariat as participants in the meeting. In this connection, the Secretariat understands that **Mr Zhigang Ge** (China Nuclear Data Center, China Institute of Atomic Energy, P.O. Box 275 (41), BEIJING 102413, E-mail: gezg@ciae.ac.cn) and **Mr Jimin Wang** (China Nuclear Data Center, China Institute of Atomic Energy, P.O. Box 275 (41), BEIJING 102413, E-mail: jmwang1027@sina.com) could make a valuable contribution to the work of the meeting and your Government may wish to consider nominating them for this purpose.

The IAEA will provide Mr Ge with a lump sum of €1620 for the travel expenses to and from Bahadurgarh, India, and for living expenses, including incidentals, connected with the meeting. The participant will then be fully responsible for making the necessary travel arrangements and for cancellation costs, if any.

I would be grateful if your Government would consider bearing the cost of participation of Mr Jimin Wang.

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in meetings, workshops or training courses or for consultants. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

If your Government should wish, in addition, to appoint one or more observers to assist and advise the designated participants in the meeting, their name(s) should reach the IAEA by **15 January 2018**. In accordance with the established rules, Governments are expected to bear the cost of attendance of any observers they may send to IAEA meetings. Compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any

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damage to or loss of observers' personal property or for illness, injury or death occurring while travelling to or in connection with their attendance at IAEA meetings.

I would appreciate receiving your Government's response not later than **15 January 2018**. As subsequent correspondence will be exchanged directly between the Scientific Secretary of the meeting, Mr Naohiko Otsuka of the Division of Physical and Chemical Sciences (Email: N.Otsuka@iaea.org), and the participants, the full names and complete contact details (including postal address, telephone/fax numbers, and email address) of nominated participants should be provided.
